## **Certificate Training Program ©**

### **Attachment Treatment: Theory & Techniques©** **Modified Interaction Guidance (M.I.G.)**

Is a very powerful Attachment based intervention that focuses on working with a parent and child up to the age of 12. The essence of MIG is teaching parents better attunement; to recognize subtle cues from their child, and respond more thoughtfully.

This process involves videotaping an interaction between a parent/caregiver and their child, observing the interaction together, highlighting moments of synchrony and disynchrony, and therapeutically discussing alternate responses. The goal is to develop observation skills as well as more effective techniques in a highly supportive, strengths based, and positive milieu. Research suggests that healthier attachments are formed quickly, within 5 to 7 sessions.

**Training Format:** The format of the training will include a combination of lecture and practice. Participants will be taught the most current assessment and intervention tools and will be putting these into practice with cases from their own work settings. Cases will be presented and supervised as part of the regularly scheduled training sessions. All of the elements of *Modified Interaction Guidance* will be taught in the first 5 weekly sessions. Participants must be present at all of these training sessions. Following the five training sessions, trainees will continue to meet on a weekly basis to review videotaped case material as well as to practice using assessment tools within small peer groups. Program trainers will be present for one peer group session per month, offering supervision of case material until April, 2010. Each trainee will be required to present two complete cases in order to be certified.

### **Admission Requirements:**

- Prerequisite: *Attachment Treatment: Theory and Techniques ©* Level 1 and 2 or equivalent.
- Clinicians working with an active caseload which includes children and families.
- Master degree in Counselling, Psychology, Social Work or Marriage & Family Therapy or equivalent is preferred. Consideration will be given for those with Bachelor degrees combined with relevant experience.
- Applicants must be prepared to work with two families from their caseload. The first family must be ready to begin work at the beginning of November 2010.

Maximum of 5 participants per group. Selection interviews will be conduct .
